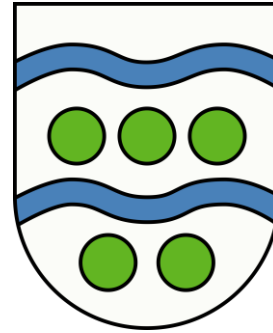


Up-to-date information from the Samtgemeinde Fintel

Dear fellow citizens !

Given the rapid spread of the coronavirus worldwide with its fatal consequences, we are all very uncertain. We don't have a subscription to all that has been a matter of course for us so far.

Because the Corona virus is highly contagious, it is now important for everyone. Everyone can now prove to do everything to protect themselves and others.

The team of the velvet community of Fintel as well as our external helpers and consultants are just as insecure as you, because the situation we have to deal with is also new for us. We do our best every day to keep up with the latest developments, to inform you and to get everything you need. But now there is no right or wrong. Action is needed. For all of us ! Also for you !

In the following we would like to give you current information and recommendations for action.

What CAN YOU DO NOW?

As a citizen:

Please stay at home. Do nothing that is not necessarily necessary. Strict contact prohibitions apply from now on! Please also check the media, the display and our homepage .**The stay in the public space is only on its own, with another person not living in the household or in the circle of the relatives of the own household**

Allowed. The way to work, emergency care, shopping, doctor's visits, help for other or individual sports and exercise in the open air as well as other necessary activities remain possible.



Groups of cowardly people in public places, in homes and private facilities are unacceptable in view of the serious situation in our country. We will monitor violations of the contact restrictions as a regulatory authority and the police and sanction them in the event of infringements.

Pay more attention to the strictest hygiene measures in your home than before. Clean the objects that frequently touch them consciously or unconsciously. Remember all items, such as door and hand grips, computers, and remote controls. Clean your mobile phone several times a day. Use disinfectants in stock or cleaning cloths and washcloths soaked in detergent, soap or washing-up liquid. Use disposable paper towels as much as you can in your everyday life. Do not throw cloths into the toilet, but into the residual waste; cloths can lead to blockages in the duct system and interfere with the cleaning process on our sewage treatment plants.

If possible, do not touch your face.



As an employer:

Try to employ as many home office workers as possible. Avoid unnecessary or movable business trips for your staff as well. You may now be deferring work processes that are not urgently needed. Provide cleaning supplies to all employees in the entrance areas and workplaces. In some establishments it may be appropriate and reasonable to prohibit the use of social areas. Appeal for breaks at their workplaces for a transitional period and to limit contacts to an absolutely necessary degree. Always keep at least 1.5 meters away from colleagues. Please make sure that doors and door latches are cleaned regularly, as should increased hygiene in the workplace. Think about tools, machines and other controls, handles, keyboards, computer mice, phones, desk surfaces, armrests, and desk utensils.

As an employee:

Remember that you can be the carrier of the virus yourself. Do not walk the way to work unless your hands are washed. Please clean your handles and controls on the bike and on motorized dual wheels. Clean your vehicle door handles, door handles, handlebars, shift levers, and controls. Think of a regular cleaning of your key dish.



Stay clear of your colleagues. Sanitize your tools and everything you need to do your job as a tool, if possible. Show understanding that the day-to-day work is changing due to the current hazard situation. Suggest improvements to your employer to ensure the best possible hygiene conditions in your company.

When shopping:

Before you go shopping: Please check if there is a delivery service. More and more companies in our environment are offering this kind of thing. This is especially true for the gastronomy. Check out the websites of the regional shops and restaurants.



Soon, thanks to the cooperation of **the BürgerBus Association** with **the Brunkshof in Stemmen**, it will be possible to get food delivered from there to your home. Orders and information can be found at www.brunkshof.de or **at telephone number: 04267 / 93 00 34.**

Food supply: Occasionally call your neighbor and ask him if you should bring something. Please go alone and only with washed hands for shopping! Keep as few items as possible in the store and do not return any items that have been touched. Keep clear of other customers and at checkout. Please do not hamster! It makes no sense and makes others insecure. Food supply remains secure.



As parents:

Talk to your children and explain the dangers of spreading infection. Show your children how to keep items clean. Stay away from others while walking.

Note on the established emergency services:

Emergency care provided in day care centers and schools is directed exclusively at parents who are working in indispensable professions, as long as they are not able to care for the children by their own presence. Again, please leave your children at home as far as possible. Only in this way can we avoid contact groups that are too large. Further information can also be found on our homepage as well as on the display at daycare centers and schools.

As neighbor:

Please take care of your neighbors and especially of elderly, sick and single citizens. They are often even more insecure than others. A phone call and holding contacts can help to relax the situation.

For symptoms of illness:

Call your family doctor or call the doctor on standby at 116117. There you will receive all the important information.
